The Westmore Association Spring 2015 Newsletter

Greetings to all members and friends of the Westmore Association. Spring has finally come to the Kingdom and it's time to look ahead to the 2015 season of summer activity on Willoughby Lake, other Westmore ponds and our beautiful mountain trails. This newsletter provides the latest information, as of mid-May, on scheduled activities and other events in Westmore and around Vermont.

Westmore News

The new Vermont Universal Recycling Law (Act 148) bans disposal of recyclables (metal, glass, plastics #1 & #2, and paper/cardboard) by July 1, 2015; leaf and yard debris and clean wood by July 1, 2016; and food scraps by July 1, 2020. Local governments are responsible for implementing the law within their jurisdiction. Westmore Town Clerk, Greg Gallagher, has provided the following information regarding the plan developed by the Town Board: "Beginning July 1, road side collection will be Saturday only for household garbage. Special 33 gallon bags with a Westmore logo will be required for garbage pickup. Bags may be purchased at the Village hall for \$3.50 per bag. No recyclable material will be accepted in the garbage bags. If garbage is taken directly to the Transfer Station the special bags will be required. Recycling will be picked up every Thursday. Clear plastic bags, as in the past, may be used, with no special Westmore bag required, however, glass, plastic, cans, paper and cardboard must be sorted. They may be put into smaller shopping bags, then into a bigger bag if you wish."

Other Vermont legislation recently passed and awaiting the Governor's signature is, "An act relating to improving the quality of State waters". Aquatic Invasive Species (AIS)

The Willoughby public boat launch access greeters educate lake visitors about invasive species, and provide courtesy watercraft inspections and boat washes to stop introductions. In addition to our concern about aquatic plants, Zebra and Quaga mussels, the spinney water flea, (which is not actually a flea, but a crustacean), has been found in Lake Champlain. Greeter data from past years have shown that several boats launched in Willoughby have previously been in Lake Champlain. Two grants from the State to the Town will be used in support of AIS initiatives. One grant will be used to purchase a hot water pressure washer to clean boats that have been on infested waters. It has been shown that a hot water wash is effective in controlling the water flea. Plans are being developed to set up a wash station and train staff and volunteers in the operation of the washer. This same grant will also be used to develop a map showing where beds of milfoil are located, which must be avoided by power boats. Other invasive species control measures, including milfoil harvesting and the greeters will also be supported with state grant funds, a town appropriation and contributions from the Westmore Association. New England Lakes Conference

The New England chapter of the National Association of Lake Management Society annual conference will be held May 29-30 in Burlington Vermont on the shores of Lake Champlain. Trails and Town Forest

New Willoughby Map

A new color depth chart of Willoughby Lake has been produced using GPS and SONAR instrumentation that shows areas much deeper than previously known, as well as some strange features that might just be Willey!. The lake map is overlain on a detailed color aerial photo that shows local roads nearby ponds and other features of the landscape, including some camps and docks if they are not covered by trees. The map will be available in two sizes,12x18 in. for \$15 and 24x36 in.for \$40 plus postage. Maps of both sizes may be ordered from the WA web site with the smaller size available at the Willoughby Store.


