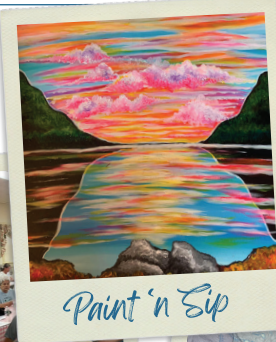

Willoughby Paint 'n Sip Saturday, July 11th

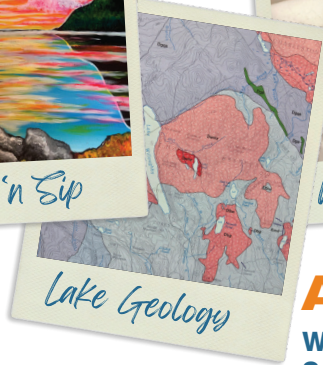
2:00-5:00 pm at Fellowship Hall, \$40 per person

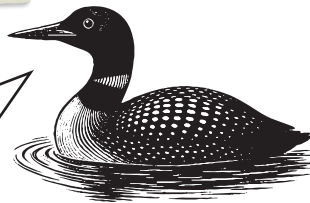

Summer Yoga Series July 2nd - August 20th

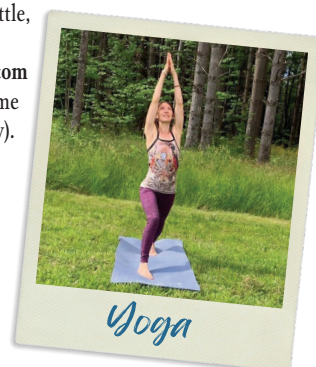
